

Associate Civil Engineer – Floodplain Management

The City of Sacramento, **Department of Utilities** is currently seeking to fill an Associate Civil Engineer position on their Floodplain Management team, under the Development Review & Floodplain Management Section.

This position will be assigned a variety of tasks related to floodplain management and flood control. Typical assignments include: reviewing development projects for compliance City's Floodplain Ordinance, training City staff, updating the City's Flood Insurance Rate Maps, reviewing hydraulic models, providing technical support for the City's Operation and Maintenance Levee Maintenance and Inspection group, writing annual reports, assisting with the City's Community Rating System program, answering questions from the public on flood risk and flood insurance, conducting outreach, managing grants, providing technical support for the Security and Emergency Preparedness group, and working with many stakeholders such as Sacramento Area Flood Control Agency, Federal Emergency Management Agency, Department of Water Resources, and Sacramento County.

Desired qualification beyond minimum requirements include:

- Strong communication skills
- Experience with customer service
- Knowledge of hydrology & hydraulics
- Background in regulatory compliance

Possession of a Certificate of Registration as a Professional Engineer in the State of California is required and must be verifiable.
