FEMA's mission is to support our citizens and first responders to ensure that as a nation we work together to build, sustain, and improve our capability to prepare for, protect against, respond to, recover from, and mitigate all hazards. The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) of the Department of Homeland Security is seeking a limited number of applicants for TEMPORARY jobs in multiple locations in GA. Seasonal - Not to exceed 120 days with possibility of extension. Local hire appointment does not entitle you to Federal Civilian status. Salaries are comparable to local prevailing wages.

Job Duties:

In this position you will be responsible for conducting Environmental and Historic Preservation compliance reviews. Understanding of NEPA and NHPA is a plus. Knowledge of Environmental Laws and Executive Orders and Historic Preservation Laws is a plus.

Typical assignments include:

- Preparation and/or review of studies, written reports, charts, graphs, maps, and other documentation that describes the technical methods and results of surveys of

properties identified for environmental impact statements, environmental assessments, survey reports, and design memorandum.

- Preparation of documentation may concern items of archaeological, geological, and historical significance in relation to other environmental factors that are considered in selecting and recommending the most desirable plan of development.
- Strong communication skills and be able to handle a stressful work environment.
- Demonstrate computer knowledge, interpersonal, and customer service skills, including Microsoft Office.
- Experience with Google Earth is preferred but not required.
