Candidates should demonstrate a deep understanding of flood control including subjects such as hydraulics, hydrology, geotechnical studies, drainage, channel flow, and storm water management. Experience in the Central Valley is preferred but not required, however a grasp of the unique characteristics of the region will be needed to succeed in this position. A high degree of knowledge of how a flood control agency interacts with other public agencies is crucial.

SJAFCA's next Executive Director will be someone who is energetic and an out-of-the box thinker. Consensus building will be a key element in the Agency's success, so the successful candidate will clearly demonstrate strong interpersonal skills, the ability to articulate a vision, and the capability to rally others to that vision. In this position, a capacity to see the bigger picture is imperative. The Executive Director must be able to work independently and at a high level of efficiency with minimal direction. The successful candidate must be comfortable taking ownership of the process in order to fulfill the Board's vision. Candidates should demonstrate an ability to work successfully with a Board of Directors or similar body.

Preferred qualifications for the Executive Director position include possession of a professional engineer license in California or the ability to obtain; financial management experience in the public sector, including fund accounting and budgeting; and land use knowledge and an economic/development background.
